PTO Advisory is going to be hosting a BOE candidate's forum on Wednesday, October 23 at 7pm in the PHS AP Room. It is an opportunity to hear from the candidates and ask them questions or find out more about their platforms. They are hoping to videotape or live stream it.

Our PHS PTO is officially a non-profit organization. With the help of PHS parent and attorney, Amy Smith, we filed the paperwork this past summer and were approved on August 15. Thank you to Amy Smith for volunteering her professional expertise to make this happen.

The board is In the process of formulating our budget. We are beginning with about \$13,000. There are about \$10,000 of available funds. The budget will be printed on the back of the agenda and on our website in future meetings.

Principal's Report - Paul Jones (pjones@region15.org)

There is interest from a faculty member in coming to our meetings as our Teacher Representative beginning next month.

There was a question at the last meeting about recycling the large food aluminum pans. They are largely not used in our facility but when they are brought in, they can be recycled in the same bin where we use large aluminum containers. Culinary arts was informed about this for their use. Cardboard is able to be recycled. The Ecology Club is meeting and expanding recycling opportunities.

Sit With Us app will be run by the psychology intern this year and a student volunteer has stepped up to recruit students. This was designed by a teenager who struggled with who to sit with during lunch. The purpose is to connect student ambassadors with kids who can use the app to request assistance finding someone to sit with. Newtown is using it and it is building relationships with the students.

October 22nd is the 8th Grade Open House here at PHS. The Director of Guidance and Paul will speak. The department chairs will be available to answer questions.

New graduation requirements have been reviewed at the BOE Policy & Curriculum committee to realign with the state of CT statutes that require certain amounts of credit and the types of credits. There must be a minimum of 25 credits and a mastery experience.

October 21st is Spirit Week. Students are voting on the theme for each of the 5 days. They decorate the halls and wear class color that Thursday. Friday is the pep rally in the afternoon with games and activities and the band plays and the football game is that evening. The dance is Saturday and will be held at the Wyndham. Only Pomperaug students are allowed.

Senior Semi-Formal is November 9th at the Grand Oak Villa. The Junior Ring dance is November 16th also at the Grand Oak Villa.

PSATs will be given on Wednesday, October 16 for grades 9-12. Seniors will receive a form in advisory to be signed if they are college visiting or shadowing that day.

The marching band played at the Board Of Education meeting last night and sounded great.

Department Chairs have met with Paul and homework practices are being reviewed. Students will be asked about their load in classes. A parent stressed that it is important for our kids to be honest with the staff about how long they are taking to get homework completed.

This year we will be performing two full-stage productions in December and March and a black box production in May. This came from feedback from parents and it also allows someone doing Spring sports to have an opportunity to be in the production. There will be a one-act festival directed by Seniors in the black box.
